March 31: Beverly Straube, senior curator at the Jamestown-Yorktown Foundation will give a talk titled "Collectively Indispensable, Individually Obscure: the Women of 17th-Century Virginia" exploring stories of real women in early Virginia.



April 28: Ron Chase, founding Director of the Gum Springs Historical Society and Museum will discuss this historically Black community located near the Mount Vernon Estate in Alexandria, VA. that was a sanctuary for free Blacks and enslaved people who fled captivity.
